Unfortunately following the announcement of the new Omicron variant the senior management team have taken the decision to suspend our viewing sessions for all parents with the exception of Preschool parents or parent of children with a medical condition that you need to be there to monitor from 1st December 2021. There will be an access list at reception, those who have access please ensure you are wearing a face covering at all time when in the building unless you are exempt. This has been a hard decision to make and we apologise for any inconveniences it may cause. However we have to protect our staff and all the children who attend so we ask that you respect the choices made and show your support. We would also like to thank the parents who have already supported our decision.

We would also ask that is you suspect your child had Covid-19 or is ill with coughs and cold that you keep them off and this also applies if the is a positive case in the house hold. Whilst we are aware that under 18s don't have to isolate we are requesting you to keep your child at home.






