Entering the Gym in the Evenings

In the evenings after 5pm the front door will now be locked as it was before the pandemic. We have noticed that many children are coming to the door on their own and not being dropped at the door by their parents. This means you will have to enter the door code on the silver panel at the side of the door, you will all receive an email with the door code please keep an eye out. After entering the code pull the right door for your child to enter.

We are keeping our viewing to once every four weeks as it is currently working well with the space we have on both the balcony and in the car park. For parents to exit the gym they will have to press the green button on the left side of the door and push the left door to exit.

When it is not your turn to watch please make sure you are getting out your car and collecting your child from the door, this applies to both Club and Rec gymnasts. Coaches will not allow a gymnast out the red door unless they can see a parent stood within the grey gated area.

Lots happened during February, our Grade 1&2 gymnasts competed in the Evolve Pre-Grade Comp and some in NW & GM Grades. We ran a Valentine's raffle, winners announced below! We had a Half-Term filled with different Holiday Camps, with lots of returning faces and also some new ones and we had our first Parties back since 2020! Our new yault also arrived!

In March club gymnasts will prepare for competitions coming up, with advanced Rec gymnasts also starting to prepare for competitions. A new competition leotard has been announced for club gymnasts. Rec gymnasts will be completing BAGA badges for the last time, before we say goodbye to the old scheme.
