
The <u>Apparatus Finals</u>

NDP Grades — Organisation for 2009

You have brought the book, you have tried to decide who will go Regional and who will go National, you have scratched your head on the performance pathway and have sort of started the training. Excellent because this is how we are going to run the comps.

### **Regional Grades**

These will be run in the Counties and the dates are on the front page of this newsletter and are on the new NWGA WTC website. Take care not to miss the entry dates, for instance GM will be before Christmas. There will be 8 competitions, Grades 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 in age, 13 out of age, 14 in age and 14 out of age.

The Counties will award the Grades Certificates and select their teams to represent the County in the Regional Finals.

The teams will be the top 6 gymnasts in each Grade. In addition to the team the 7th and 8th gymnasts will be allowed to compete as individuals on finals day.

### **Regional Grades Finals**

This competition will be run by the NWGA WTC at Birchwood on 8th March. The finals will be run for Grades 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 in age, 13 out of age, 14 in age and 14 out of age both as a team competition for the 6 gymnasts representing the County, but also to crown the overall champions who will be selected as the highest score from the teams and the 7th and 8th gymnasts from the County who are competing as individuals.

There will be team trophies and an overall trophy for the top team score from 9, 10, 11, 12, the average 13 and the average 14 scores added together.

Please note that the Regional finals the Grade 13 and 14 gymnasts will not need to redo their range and conditioning set, but must pass it in the County Comp to qualify.

### National Grades

The National Grades will be run by the NWGA WTC at Birchwood on 7th March. This will be for Grades 5, 6, 7 and 8 and will select a team to represent the NWGA at the national finals at Cocks Moors Woods Leisure Centre (TBC) on 25th/26th April 2009.

### **Compulsories**

Compulsory 3 and 4 will be run by the NWGA WTC at Birchwood on 7th March. In the same format as previous years. We will select a team to represent the NWGA at the national finals at Cocks Moors Woods Leisure Centre (TBC) on 2nd/3rd May 2009.

Confused? I hope not, but a Grades pack should be with all affiliated clubs, the information is on the website and Fiona Wright is always on hand to answer the detailed questions that coaches inevitably have.
